

ORDINANCE 771

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3-3-29 BY ADDING SUBSECTION 40 TO THE CAMANCHE, IOWA CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ON 8<sup>th</sup> AVENUE BETWEEN 5<sup>th</sup> STREET AND 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMANCHE, IOWA:

**Section 1. Purpose.** The purpose of this ordinance is to establish that there will be no parking on 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue between 5<sup>th</sup> Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Section 2. Facts Found.** The City Council hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- 1) 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue is a narrow stretch of road which services 3 houses and a City alleyway.
- 2) Frequent parking by large vehicles on this stretch creates a hazard for traffic and access for emergency vehicles.
- 3) Attempts to resolve this circumstance have not been successful.

**Section 3. Amendment.** The Camanche, Iowa, Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

**3-3-29 Stopping, Standing, Driving, or Parking prohibited in Specific Places.**

**40. 8<sup>th</sup> Ave from 5<sup>th</sup> Street to 6<sup>th</sup> Street.**


“No parking”/signs posted. Parking is prohibited on 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 5<sup>th</sup> Street to 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Section 4. Repealer.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5. Severability Clause.** If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudicated invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 6. When Effective.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final approval, passage, and publication as provided by law.
