June 2, 2020

The City Council of the City of Camanche, Iowa met in regular session June 2, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. via electronic means due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Present on roll call: Mayor Trevor Willis, presiding, and council members Bowman, Varner, Weller and Brightman. Absent: Schnoor. Also present were City Administrator Kida and Department Heads Reid, Schutte and Schneider.

A moment of silent prayer was observed. Mayor Willis led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moved by Bowman, second by Varner to approve the Agenda. On roll call – all Ayes.

Mayor Willis opened a Public Hearing regarding General Obligation Loan Agreement Not to Exceed \$400,000 for City Hall expansion at 6:08 p.m. Kida noted that no comments were received at City Hall prior to the meeting. He unmuted attendees to allow them to speak. In the absence of public comments, the Mayor closed the Public Hearing at 6:08 p.m.

Visitor Erin Cole was not in attendance.

Public comments will be limited to the end of the meeting due to conducting the meeting electronically.

Approve renewal of Cigarette/Tobacco/Nicotine/Vapor permits as submitted by Casey’s Marketing Company, DEV Supermart (Food Pride) and Kwik Star #632; Adopt a Resolution Authorizing an Abatement in the Urban Revitalization Area; Approve Proposal for One Annual Street Sweeping BWC Excavating \$4,225.00. On roll call – all Ayes.

Moved by Varner, second by Weller to Adopt a Resolution Expressing Intent to Enter into General Obligation City Hall Loan Agreement. On roll call – all Ayes.

Regarding reinstating water shut offs and utility late fees, Kida said the Governor’s latest proclamation authorized reinstatement of foreclosures and evictions as well as utility shut offs. We are giving people an additional 30 days from today. We have around 20 people who have not paid from the previous quarter.

Moved by Bowman, second by Varner to Adopt a Resolution Reinstating Water Shut Offs and Utility Late Fees for the City of Camanche. On roll call – all Ayes.

Quarterly garbage and recycling charges were discussed. As planned during the budget process, the rate will increase 25 cents per month this year.

Moved by Bowman, second by Brightman to Adopt a Resolution Increasing the Quarterly Charge for Residential Garbage and Recycling Collection in the City of Camanche. On roll call – all Ayes.

The Subcommittee for the purpose of City Hall Addition and Renovations was discussed. Kida wants the Fire Chief and Police Chief as well as the Billing Clerk and City Clerk on the Committee. Mayor Willis asked Varner to participate in his place and Bowman volunteered. The Subcommittee will be Andrew Kida, Chief Schutte, Chief Reid, Christy Schutte, Toni Schneider, Mayor Pro Tem Paul Varner and Councilman Dave Bowman.

Moved by Bowman, second by Weller to approve the City Hall Addition Subcommittee appointments. On roll call – all Ayes.

Kida said he participated in a retraining with FEMA today. He will now file a COVID claim and has asked department heads for their information. He reported that he did work at the Community Center and he is comfortable with moving the Council meetings there. The public can observe with You Tube but cannot participate using the Free Conference at the same time. After a brief discussion, it was decided the next Council meeting will be at the Community Center.

Bowman asked if someone could attend the Library Board meeting in his place tomorrow to discuss the increase in the Quad City Times subscription cost. Weller said the City sponsored lunch was yesterday and thanked everyone for their support.

Public Comments: Kida unmuted individual citizens. When everyone was unmuted, Mayor Willis invited comments. There were none.

Mayor Willis adjourned the meeting at 6:31 p.m.
