City Administrator Kida presented 5 copies of the City's proposal to the Cory Snodgrass, President of the Bargaining Unit. This is the starting point for negotiations. The Bargaining Unit presented their proposal at the last Council meeting.

Kida said he met with Mayor Pruett regarding Committee and Commission Appointments. The Mayor selected Paul Varner as Mayor Pro Tem and Councilman Determann to take over the committee assignments former Councilman Brightman fulfilled during his term.

Moved by Councilman Bowman, second by Councilman Varner to approve Mayoral Committee and Commission Appointments. On roll call – all Ayes.

City Attorney Braydon Roberts gave an update on 21st Street. Mr. Cook's legal description was mailed to him and to his attorney last week. Roberts heard from the attorney's office today that Mr. Cook's attorney is out of the office until mid-January. He has not heard anything further from Mr. Cook. Roberts did speak with the owner of the other properties and he is willing to sign a deed so they will get that done.

Kida recognized employees for their years of service-Troy Alderman 7 years, Jim Sowle 10 years, Jeff Moore 12 years and Mike Yackshaw 29 years. Regarding City Hall, the door hardware is still not available. The electrical inspection is complete but some of the subcontractor employees have been out with COVID. There will be a Council training session next week on Tuesday at 6:00 p.m. It is budget time. He will also be forming a negotiations committee.

Mayor Pro Tem Varner called for public comments. There were none.

Mayor Pro Tem Varner adjourned the meeting at 6:21 p.m.
