Payment agreements are allowed, but **must** be turned in with the 25% deposit before the deadline of each billing cycle.

No open burning during burn bans, first offense \$110.

** It is illegal to burn leaves in the street. All burns must be attended and controlled. It is also illegal to brush your leaves into the street.
