## **Burning Regulations**

Burning in Camanche is only permitted 10:00AM to 5:00PM

**Thursday** 

Saturday

Only yard waste may be burned.

Fire must be attended and water source must be present.

No open burning during burn bans, first offense \$110.



Golf carts may only be driven by persons 18 years of age or older, with a valid driver's license.

Golf carts with factory-installed seatbelts must be maintained.

All occupants will be restrained in an available seatbelt while cart is in motion.

Children under 1 year and less than 20lbs must be secured in a rear-facing car seat. Car seat must be secured to golf cart.

Children 1-6 years old must be in a car seat or booster seat. Car seat must be secured to golf cart.

No passengers may carry or hold other passengers while golf cart is moving.

No passengers may ride in or on cargo areas while golf cart is in motion.

Golf carts without seatbelts will have no passengers under 18 years of age.

### **Billing**

It has come to our attention that there have been some issues with mail not reaching our residents, or our office in a timely fashion. We recommend that water customers pay their bills online, over the phone, or in person to avoid payments arriving after the due date. The City is unable to forgive any fees assessed to delinquent accounts due to mailing issues. The added credit card fee incurred when paying online or with a card over the phone is approximately half the cost of the fee incurred on a past due bill.

Bills are mailed out March 10, June 10, September 10, and December 10. Payments are due April 6, July 6, October 6, and January 6.

## **UTV Reminders**

Drivers of UTVs must be 18 years or older and have a valid driver's license.

All occupants must use seatbelts.

Children under 1 year and less than 20lbs must be secured in a rear-facing car seat. Car seat must be secured properly to UTV.

Children 1-6 years old must be in a car seat or booster seat, car seat or booster seat must be properly secured to UTV.

No more than 1 person per seat.

No person may ride in the lap of another.

The number of passengers shall not exceed the number of factory-installed seatbelts.

No driving dangerously or recklessly.

No driving over the posted speed limit or 35 MPH, whichever is less.
