

ORDINANCE 780-A

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CAMANCHE, IOWA MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING TITLE 1 CHAPTER 4 SECTION 2 OF THE CAMANCHE CODE OF ORDINANCES.**

Section 1. **Purpose.** The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Camanche Municipal Code by modifying the Election Precincts Ordinance to correct a designation error.

Section 2. **Facts Found.** The City Council of the City of Camanche, Iowa hereby makes the following findings of fact:

1. The City of Camanche Adopted Ordinance 1-4: Election Precincts as required by Iowa Code
2. An error was found in designating the northern border of Precinct 2 as Highway 67
3. The Correct identification of the northern border of Precinct 2 is Highway 30

Section 3. **Amendment.** Chapter 1-4 Section 2 is repealed and replaced with the following language inserted in lieu thereof:

1. Precinct: 2: All parts of the City lying north and west of the following described line:

Beginning at the westerly-most point where the corporate limits of the City of Camanche intersect with the centerline of U.S. Highway 67;

Thence northeasterly along the centerline of Highway 67 to the intersection of South Washington Boulevard;

Thence easterly and northeasterly along the centerline of South Washington Boulevard to the centerline of 7th Avenue/Central Steel Road;

Thence northerly along the centerline of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Central Steel Road to the corporate limit on US Highway 30.

Precinct 2 includes, by agreement between the City Council of the City of Camanche and the Clinton County Board of Supervisors, Census Tract 8, Block 3002.

Section 4. **Repealer.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 5. **Severability Clause.** If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect this ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudicated invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. **When Effective.** This ordinance shall be in full effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
