City Attorney Frey said there were some minor formatting changes made from the First Reading. City Attorney Current said he had a conversation with the County Attorney and their Ordinance dealing with this issue is a sub-ordinance. After much discussion about the possible changes, it was decided to table the Third Reading and the Adoption of the Ordinance until it can be updated as appropriate.

Mayor Pruett read the Second Reading of an Ordinance Amending the Camanche Iowa Municipal Code Chapter 3-3-70 Golf Carts and 3-3-66 Off-Road Vehicles by Title Only.

On roll call – Ayes – Councilmen Schnoor, Bowman, Weller. Councilman Varner arrived after the vote. Nays – None.

Mayor Pruett read the Third Reading of an Ordinance Amending the Camanche Iowa Municipal Code Chapter 3-3-70 Golf Carts and 3-3-66 Off-Road Vehicles by Title Only.

Moved by Councilman Bowman, second by Councilman Schnoor to Approve the Third Reading of an Ordinance Amending the Camanche Iowa Municipal Code Chapter 3-3-70 Golf Carts and 3-3-66 Off-Road Vehicles by Title Only. On roll call – Ayes – Councilmen Bowman, Weller, Schnoor. Councilman Varner arrived after the vote. Nays – None.

Moved by Councilman Bowman, second by Councilman Weller to Adopt an Ordinance Amending the Camanche Iowa Municipal Code Chapter 3-3-70 Golf Carts and 3-3-66 Off-Road Vehicles. On roll call – Ayes – Councilmen Bowman, Schnoor, Weller. Councilman Varner arrived after the vote. Nays – None.

Mayor Pruett read the First Reading of an Ordinance Amending Chapter 18 of the Camanche Zoning Ordinance 18.60.015 General Supplementary Regulations: Accessory Building and Structure Location.

Regarding the limit of two buildings, Councilman Bowman asked if we currently have properties in violation. City Administrator Kida said this is the law put in place after the fact. Existing structures will not need to be changed. Current added that a new classification is proposed with the creation of the term accessory private garage. There was a lengthy discussion of the meaning of terms describing garages and accessory buildings as they relate to the Ordinance amendment. Also discussed was the square footage of the home where the building is built and whether the intent is to include a second story and how to measure a split foyer. The members of the Council agreed to table the Ordinance amendment until these points are clarified in the amendment. Councilman Bowman tried to summarize the items that need to be cleaned up as: clarify attached, detached or both, clarify the under 1,440 square feet of ground floor living space section should have the same terminology so it is clear what we mean. Kida interjected that the first line of this garage section refers to a detached accessory building and said in this whole section the big issue is the use of the word accessory private garage and said private garage means detached accessory building. Kida wants the numbers to refer only to detached garages. Current said he thinks he can come up with something that can differentiate between the two so there is no confusion in its enforcement. This item was tabled until the next meeting.

Kida presented a proposal from GovInvest for employee benefit cost forecasting service. He asked if Council would be interested in a presentation from them; it is a tool he would like to have. Councilman Bowman asked Kida about the cost. It is \$5,000 initially plus \$12,000 annually. Kida said any of these services are expensive. Members of the Council were not in favor of spending this much money but agreed to see the presentation only. Mayor Pruett asked if there are other options that cost less.

Chief Schmitz presented the September 2023 Police Department Report.

Mayor Pruett reminded everyone of Pirate Party in the Park on October 28th and said he will be in the dunk tank. Councilman Schnoor asked if the roads connecting Cedar Heights and 9th Street could be reopened; it is inconvenient for school buses. Kida said they will be open on Friday. Schnoor echoed the Party in the Park reminder, said he will be in the dunk tank and said there will be 3 or 4 food vendors there and a lot going on. Councilman Varner wished everyone a happy Halloween and urged everyone to watch out for the kids. Councilman Bowman, liaison for the Library Board, said that the RFP for the Library expansion will be going out soon. It is expected to be on the ballot in 2025 and the levy for this debt will replace the Washington Boulevard levy. He said the Fire Station open house was a good time. Public Works Director Pewe gave a detailed update on the 9th Street project, with traffic patterns changing as the final paving expected at the end of the week. Information will go out on social media as it becomes available. MidAmerican will be installing permanent lighting at the roundabout in the next few weeks, with the need to close one direction at a time. There will be signage and social media communication as this project progresses. The SCADA system is in the building/design phase. The pump for well 5 is expected to be delivered in November and installed in early December. The docks at the boat ramps will be pulled in the next two weeks. Chief Schmitz said there will be several wind turbine blades moving in the next several days so expect some traffic delays.

Mayor Pruett called for Public Comments. There were none.

Mayor Pruett adjourned the meeting at 7:01 p.m.



ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 18.60.015 GENERAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: ACCESSORY BUILDING AND STRUCTURE LOCATION OF THE CAMANCHE, IOWA CODE OF ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMANCHE, IOWA:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Zoning Chapter 18.60.015 of the Camanche, Iowa Code of Ordinances, for the regulation of Accessory Buildings and Structure Location in the City of Camanche

Section 2. Facts Found. The City Council hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- 1) The City of Camanche Zoning Ordinance regulates the size and location of accessory buildings within the City of Camanche
- 2) The Camanche Planning and Zoning Commission has reviewed and recommended adoption of amended language to incorporate in the Zoning Ordinance
- 3) The City of Camanche finds it appropriate to amend the Zoning Ordinance

Section 3. <u>Amendment</u>. The Camanche, Iowa, Code of Ordinances for Zoning Chapter 18.60.015 is hereby amended by removing the language for 18.60.015 in its entirety and replacing it with the following language:

18.60.015 Accessory Building and Structure Location: No accessory building or structure shall be constructed or located on or across a municipal sanitary sewer, water or other utility easement. Any existing accessory building or structure located on any municipal utility easement shall be removed or relocated in conformance with these regulations at the owner's expense.

"Garage, Private" means a detached accessory building or portion of a residential building housing the automobiles of the occupants of the premises. No private garage within R-1, R-2, B-2 or R-M districts shall exceed ten (10) feet in height for side wall construction, and shall not have an overall height exceeding twenty (20) feet. Properties with a principal dwelling under 1440 Square feet of gross living area as defined by the Clinton County Assessor's office shall not have an private garage exceeding 1080 square feet. Properties with more than 1440 square feet of gross living area as defined by the Clinton County Assessor's office shall not have an overall private garage exceeding one thousand five hundred (1500) square feet total area, or seventy five (75) percent of the gross living area as defined by the Clinton County Assessor's office of the related principal residence, and whichever number is lesser establishes the total area maximum for such garage or accessory building. The largest dimension of any detached accessory building or private garage in R-1, R-2, B-2, or R-M districts shall not exceed forty (40)

feet in length. In the case of the attached garage, the twenty (20) foot height limitation does not apply, however the height of the garage shall not exceed the height of the principal residence adjacent to the point of attachment to such principal residence. The number of accessory private garages shall be no more than 2 (two) buildings and the combined square footage of those buildings may not exceed the amount of square footage for a private garage allowed for that property. (Ord. 638 §3,2000).

The location and size of any accessory building shall also comply with the requirements set forth at 18.24.020 regarding set back requirements and percentage of rear-yard space which an accessory building may occupy.

Be It Further Resolved that Section 18.08.060 is hereby amended in order to correct a Scribner's error which is pertinent to the amendment to 18.60.015, to read as follows:

<u>18.08.060 Basement</u>. "Basement means a story having part but not less than one-half of its height below grade. A basement is counted as a story for the purpose of height regulations.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. <u>Severability Clause</u>. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudicated invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. When Effective. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final approval, passage, and publication as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 18-60G SPECIAL ORDINANCES: NON-UTILITY SCALE/UTILITY SCALE ORDINANCES OF THE CAMANCHE, IOWA CODE OF ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMANCHE, IOWA:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Zoning Chapter 18-60G of the Camanche, lowa Code of Ordinances, for the regulation of solar renewable energy Battery Energy Storage Systems in the City of Camanche

Section 2. Facts Found. The City Council hereby makes the following findings of fact:

- 1) The City of Camanche Zoning Ordinance does not address requirements for renewable energy Battery Energy Storage Systems within the City's jurisdiction
- 2) The Camanche Planning and Zoning Commission has reviewed and recommended adoption of amended language to incorporate in the Zoning Ordinance in order to provide governance
- 3) The City of Camanche finds it necessary to amend the Zoning Ordinance in order to provide fair regulation of Battery Energy Storage Systems within its jurisdiction

Section 3. <u>Amendment</u>. The Camanche, lowa, Code of Ordinances for Zoning Chapter 18.60-G is hereby amended by adding the following language:

Battery Energy Storage System

The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish minimum requirements and regulation of any Applicant/Developer/owner engaged in the construction, erection, placement, location, maintenance, modification, operation, and decommissioning of Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) within the City of Camanche, IA current or future land use area/s in a manner that preserves and protects the rights, privileges, and property of the City and its residents, that ensures the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the City's residents, and that provides an opportunity for economic growth and development. All future Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) projects, as well as those currently contracted by agreement permitted, or planned, shall follow this Ordinance.

A. <u>Definitions</u>. For use in this Ordinance, certain words used herein shall be defined as follows:

Agreement. A legally binding document signed by both a participating landowner and an owner or operator for a specific purpose, including but not limited to a contract, easement, or lease.

<u>Applicant</u>. The person or entity submitting the application under this Ordinance, which is normally expected to be the owner or operator of a BESS.

<u>Battery Energy Storage System (BESS)</u>. One or more devices, assembled together, capable of storing energy, not to include a stand-alone 12-volt car battery or an electric motor vehicle. A BESS may be a stand-alone project or in conjunction with a Solar Farm.

<u>BESS Construction Permit</u>. A permit issued by the City of Camanche, which is required before construction of a BESS is allowed in the City of Camanche. If a BESS is proposed in conjunction with a Solar Farm, the permits bay be combined and submitted as one application.

City Council. A council elected by City of Camanche residents.

<u>Developed Project Area</u>. The total project area that is subject to an agreement between the Owner/Operator and the Participating Landowner and is developed and utilized for placement of a BESS.

Easement. A legal agreement for the use of property for a specified purpose.

Non-Participating Landowner. A landowner who has not signed a binding agreement with the Applicant/Developer/Owner of the BESS.

<u>Occupied Structure</u>. For the purpose of this ordinance, shall include any existing occupied house, apartment, barn or machine shed regularly used by the property owner, or parties in possession of the property at the time of the permit application. * See Waiver Agreement.

<u>Owner</u>. The entity or entities with an equity interest in the Solar Farm or BESS, including their respective successors and assigns. Owner does not mean the landowner from whom a lease, easement, or other property right is acquire for locating the Solar Farm or BESS unless the landowner has an equity interest in the Solar Farm or BESS, or any person holding a security interest in the Solar Farm or BESS solely to secure an extension of credit, or a person foreclosing on such security interest provided that after foreclosure, such person seeks to sell the Solar Farm or BESS at the earliest practical date.

<u>Participating Landowner</u>. A landowner who has signed a binding agreement with the Applicant/Developer/Owner of the Solar Farm or BESS.

<u>Project Area</u>. The geographic area encompassing all components of a Solar Farm or BESS including border fencing.

<u>Property Line</u>. The legal boundary between separately owned real estate parcels, and between privately owned parcels and publicly owned land or public right of way.

<u>Setback</u>. The minimum required distance from a certain object, structure or point to the edge of any part or component of the Solar Farm or BESS.

<u>Solar Farm</u>. A commercial facility that converts sunlight into electricity, whether by photovoltaics (PV), or other conversion technology, for the primary purpose of wholesale sales of generated electricity also known as a Utility Scale Solar Installation.

<u>Utility Scale Solar Installation</u>. See definition for Solar Farm.

<u>B. Permit Application Requirements</u>. Permit application requirements for Utility Scale Solar Installations A-E shall be included with the required Project Development Plan. Permits after a Project Development Plan has been approved will require a building permit per structure.

C. General Requirement for Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS). BESS shall be subject to the following requirements:

- 1. Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) are permitted in M-RE Zoning District.
- 2. All Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) and upgrades to existing BESS shall observe the following setbacks to be measure from the edge of the BESS (not applicable to underground facilities such as cable or fencing).

Protected Area	Setback Requirement
Occupied Structure	1,000 feet from occupied structure
Property line	100 feet from property line
Public road right of way	75 feet from road right of way for paved roads 50 feet from right of way for gravel roads

- 3. <u>Safety</u>. National Electric Safety Code (NESC) compliant fencing shall be required in all project permitted by this ordinance.
- 4. <u>Insurance</u>. Applicants shall provide evidence, in the form of a certificate of insurance (COI) satisfactory to the City, showing general liability insurance coverage for the installation and operation of the project under a standard homeowner's or standard business owner's insurance policy, separate and distinct from any requirements of a public utility.
- 5. <u>Certification and Compliance</u>. A BESS shall conform to applicable industry standards, including those from the Underwriters Laboratory (UL) and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), and shall be incompliance with all applicable local, state, and federal regulatory standards and applicable electrical codes, including the National Electric Code (NEC), National Electric Safety Code (NESC), and National Fire Protection Association (NFPA). Any built plans must be submitted within twelve (12) months of completion of the project.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. <u>Severability Clause</u>. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudicated invalid or unconstitutional.


