City Hall + Important Dates

Pet Registration:

Due on or before 3/31 to avoid late fees.

*Proof of rabies vaccine required

Spayed/Neutered Dogs \$10.00

Not Spayed/Neutered Dogs \$15.00

Spayed/Neutered Cats \$3.00

Not Spayed/Neutered Cats \$6.00

*Late fee \$25.00 per animal

Dog Registration/Vaccination Event:

Saturday, April 18, 9AM-Noon.

Bring Vaccination records if your dog is current on rabies.

If your dog is not current, rabies vaccines can be obtained at the event.

More information will be released soon.

Golf Cart Registration 2026-2027

Due by June 30th, and the cost is \$50.00.

*New golf carts must be **must** be inspected and approved by Camanche PD.

UTVs require a DNR permit.

ATVs NOT permitted in Camanche.

City Hall Closures:

City Hall will be closed April 3rd to observe Easter, and May 25th to observe Memorial Day.

Trash & Recycling

Recycling and trash will be delayed by 1 day in May. Schedules are available at City Hall and on our website.

There are only 2 delays for 2026, May 25th and September 7th.

Guidelines for recycling can also be found online or in the lobby at City Hall.

Fire Safety & Smoke Alarms

Safety Tips:

1. Test smoke alarms when setting clocks forward for daylight savings time, March 8th. Replace batteries. Replace detectors over 10 years old.
2. Check Carbon Monoxide alarms.
3. Practice escape plans so that all family members know how to get out quickly in an emergency.
4. Spring cleaning - clear clutter from attics, basements, closets & garages. Including loose papers, boxes and flammable items, which can cause or add to a fire.
5. Store flammable liquids safely outdoors and in proper containers.
6. Remove dead vegetation, leaves and debris from around your home to decrease fire spread potential.
7. Check weather conditions prior to burning outdoors. Follow burning regulations (see below).
8. Stay attentive while cooking, and to burning candles or materials giving off smoke.

Always call 911 for emergencies!!

Burning Regulations

Burning in Camanche is only permitted 10:00AM to 5:00PM

Thursday

Saturday

Only **yard waste** may be burned.

Fire must be attended and water source must be present.

No open burning during burn bans, first offense \$110.



Golf Cart Reminders

Drivers MUST be 18 and have a valid driver's license.

Golf carts with factory-installed seatbelts must be maintained.

All occupants will be restrained in an available seatbelt while cart is in motion.

Kids under 1 and less than 20lbs must be secured in a rear-facing car seat. Car seat must be secured to golf cart.

Kids 1-6 must be in a car seat or booster seat. Car seat must be secured to golf cart.

Do NOT carry or hold other passengers while golf cart is moving.

Do NOT ride in or on cargo areas while golf cart is in motion.

Golf carts without seatbelts will have no passengers under 18.

Spring Cleaning

UTV Reminders

Drivers MUST be 18.

Drives MUST have a valid license.

All occupants MUST use seatbelts.

Kids under 1 and less than 20lbs MUST be secured in a rear-facing car seat.

Car seat MUST be secured properly to UTV.

Kids 1-6 MUST be in a car seat or booster seat, car seat or booster seat MUST be properly secured to UTV.

No more than 1 person per seat.

No person may ride in the lap of another.

The number of passengers shall not exceed the number of factory-installed seatbelts.

No driving dangerously or recklessly.

No driving over the posted speed limit or 35 MPH, whichever is less.
